Jones County is conveniently located between the City of Dubuque, IA (Dubuque County) and the City of Cedar Rapids, IA (Linn County).

We are experiencing dynamic development throughout our county, with Kirkwood Community College completing the construction of a 6.5 million-dollar educational facility in the City of Monticello and Jones County Regional Medical Center's 12.8 million-dollar facility in the City of Anamosa, we're just getting started!

In addition, the second-phase of Anamosa's Commercial Park is completed. This 25-lot commercial subdivision has direct access to the US Highway 151 corridor. The park features J&P Cycle, the nation's leader in after market motorcycle parts with two locations in the United States (Anamosa, IA and Daytona, FL). The park also has two completed speculative buildings (2008) for sale or lease, and the completion of the AmericInn, new to the park in 2009.

To the north, the Monticello Commercial Park is also located along the US Highway 151 corridor at the Business Highway 151 interchange. The park is home to Kirkwood Community College and most recently Yogi's Inc. and Oak Street Manufacturing. The park is ready for new development to continue, the infrastructure is in-place to accommodate your business needs.
